Building Safety Department Monthly Report - December 2017

We received 3 permit applications in December for a year-to-date total of 233; none of which were for new single-family residences. This brought the calendar year-to-date total of new residential applications to 75 and the fiscal year total to 26. We have issued 45 new home permits of the 70 projected this fiscal year.

We issued 8 permits in December, and I approved 6. The fees for permits brought in this month totaled \$16,076.17, bringing the year-to-date total fees to \$230,822.82, and the fiscal year total to \$498,943.18, both of which also include other fees, like temporary occupancy permits, copies, post-issuance reviews, fees to reopen expired permits, and reinspection fees.

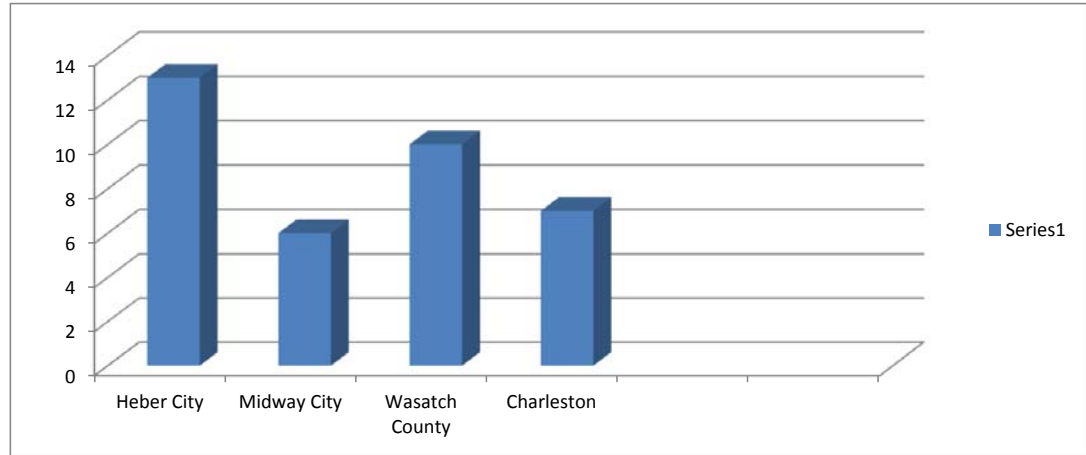

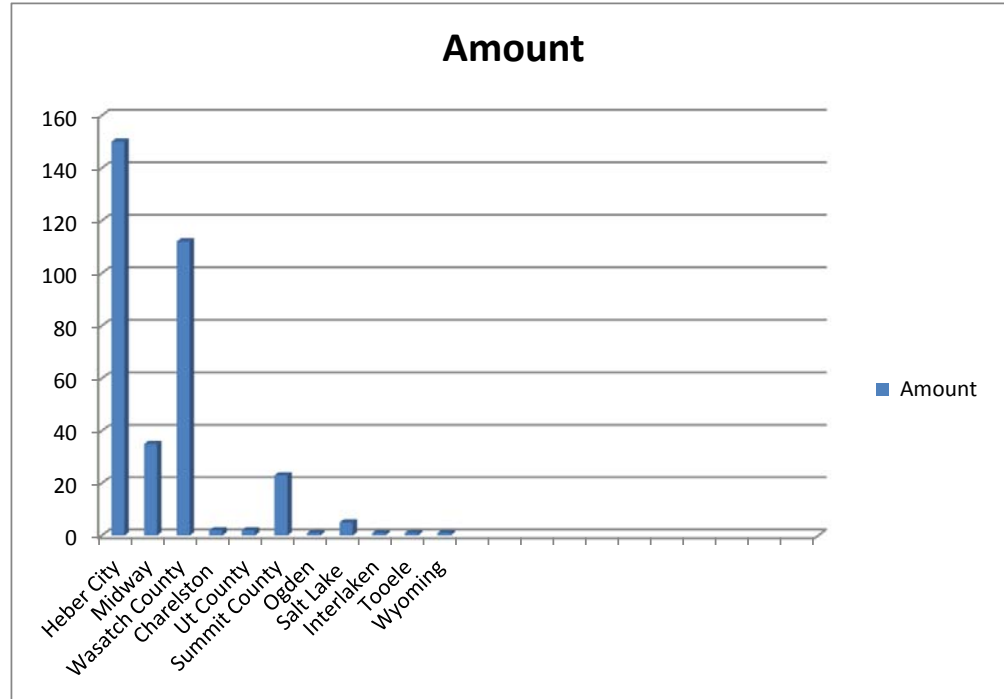
