Building Safety Department Monthly Report - September 2018

We received **20 permit applications** in September for a **year-to-date total of 164**; 8 of which were for new single-family residences. This brought the calendar year-to-date total of new residential applications to 21 and the fiscal year total to 21. We have **issued 20 new home permits** this fiscal year.

We issued **17** permits in September, and I approved **22**. The fees for permits brought in this month totaled **\$39,273.00** bringing the year-to-date total fees to **\$238,597.08**, and the fiscal year total to **\$107,650.87**, both of which also include other fees, like temporary occupancy permits, copies, post-issuance reviews, fees to reopen expired permits, and reinspection fees.

With 25% of the fiscal year reported, fees brought in equal over 15% of my department's budget. I am now including the percentage of the projected dollars my department is to bring in, which as of the end of totaled 44%.
