Mayors, Johnson, Potter and Beerman,

Thank you for the meeting yesterday to discuss a possible future transit connection between Park City, Midway and Heber City.

Below is a summary of what I understand you want MAG/UDOT/PC staff to proceed with:

1. Present this concept and the study idea to City Council meetings as requested
2. If councils are favorable conduct a study - transit demand analysis and hire a public involvement specialist at an approx total project cost of \$50k with existing and new resources including:
 - a. Approx \$37K existing federal funds managed by UDOT already at PC
 - b. MAG allocate \$5K of Local Planning Assistance funds
 - c. Heber City allocate approx \$2k
 - d. Midway City allocate approx \$1k
 - e. Park City covers remaining cost if any and manages the existing PC transit consultant and new PI consultant
3. Schedule follow up meeting February 13th, 2019 9:30 AM at the Heber City office building

Just respond to this email with any changes or an approve and MAG will consider this your request for our assistance and we will proceed accordingly.
