| | Natural grade is defined in section 02.05.025 as follows: Elevation of the existing surface of the land prior to commencement of construction of any improvements proposed or any previous site disturbance. If the structure is higher than 35 feet, it will not be approved. For structures between 30 and 35 feet, an elevation certificate will be required. |
| | SLOPE of the lot. If the slope under any part of the proposed structure is greater than 5%, an elevation certificate will be required. |
| | ELEVATION CERTIFICATE is required for structures between 30 and 35 feet high, above natural grade. Completion of this will be required before the permit is issued. |
