Fire Usage Instructions:

- Unscrew water lid from the side of the fire hydrant, install the Fire Hydrant Flow Meter and Flow Control Valve.
- When opening the Fire Hydrant Make sure the flow control valve is in the off position and open the fire hydrant to the full operating position. Notice: Extremely High Water Pressure in the system, turn valve on slowly to prevent a water hammer in the water system.
- Use the Red Flow valve: to pull water from the system. Always proceed with slowly when operating valve slowly in the ON or Off Positions.
- Always use the designated Fire Hydrant at the designated location. Report any damage or problems to the Flow Meter, Flow Control Valve or Fire Hydrant. These devices will be inspected before deposit will be returned.
- When finished with fire hydrant, turn flow control valve off and then turn the fire hydrant of in the clockwise position. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN Hydrant Valve or use a cheater. All Fire Hydrants are Dry Barrel Hydrants, water will drain off from the barrel of the hydrant one hydrant valve is in the closed position.
