



Wasatch County COVID-19 Updates 1/4/2021

A drive through COVID19 vaccination site is set up at the Wasatch County Events Center parking lot. Following the state plan, WCHD has been vaccinating non-hospital health care providers and emergency medical responders. Heber Valley hospital has also received and vaccinated staff at their facility.

The Event Center parking lot drive through site will also be used for TestUtah rapid COVID19 **testing** these days and times:

January 4: 8:00am-3:00pm	January 5: 12:00pm-7:00pm
January 11: 8:00am-3:00pm	January 12:00pm-7:00pm

COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution Timeline:

Hospital healthcare workers are being vaccinated by their employers.

Long-term care facility healthcare workers are being vaccinated by their employers with the help of national pharmacy chains, such as CVS and Walgreens or by other local providers the Utah Department of Health has contracted with.

Home healthcare workers, Non-hospital healthcare workers, EMS, Fire and Law Enforcement officers are currently being vaccinated by local health departments.

School staff- We expect to have enough vaccines to start offering it to K-12 school staff in mid-January. This timeline depends on how much vaccine our state receives and when. School districts and local health departments are coordinating the vaccine distribution.

Utahns 75 and older will receive the vaccine as we receive more vaccines and begin Phase 2 of the

distribution plan. We expect this to happen as soon as mid-February.

Vaccines will then be given to additional age groups, people with certain underlying medical conditions, and those who live in congregate settings which put them at higher risk for the virus that causes COVID-19.

Utahns 65 and older are currently anticipated to receive vaccine in March or April 2021. You do not need to “sign up” or “get on the list” to be vaccinated. The vaccine should be available to Utahns at a variety of community locations, including your local pharmacy, your doctor’s office, and [local health department](#).

All Utahns anticipated to have vaccine available between March and July 2021. Locations where you can get vaccinated will be posted at <https://vaccinefinder.org/>.
