Burgener-Boss Home & Farmstead

Andreas Burgener and his wife, Magdalena, their two small children, and his father, Jacob, came to Utah and Midway in 1874. He built the older two-story structure in 1875.

The most important feature of this property is the fact that it retains all the major buildings that were erected on the farmstead: the two-story home, the granary, a smokehouse (1875); the barn (1885); chicken coop (1920); and an outhouse of an unknown date. The home passed to Andrea's grandson, Conrad Boss and still remains in the family.

This home and its out buildings are on the National Register of Historic Places.
