

Midway City Public Works Departmental Information

Please Read the following information, It Pertains to all Midway City Residents / Home Owners, Contractors, Subcontractors and Developers. Building Permit holders will need to sign and date this notice after reading.

All appointment scheduling requires a twenty-four hour/two business days' notice prior to the requested time and date.

Building lots with existing utilities may request water meter to be installed, once a building permit has been issued. Please note water meter installation requires two business days notification.

Public Facility Deposits, must have all amenities, utilities and landscaping within the City Street and Public Utility Right-of-Way completed to City Code & Construction Standards before inspections will be performed or deposits released. Inspections will be performed from April 1st to November 1st. Weather Permitting. Deposits are returned to the person who submitted the fee to the City with the building permit. Call (435) 654-3223 X #7 for an appointment. Please note CCR's belong to private development, homeowners and property owners are still required to be, in compliance with City Standards.

No Water Meter Jumpers, Hose Bibs or other connections are allowed in the to be used in place of a Midway City Water Meter. illegal Connections may result in a class b misdemeanor and or the water service disconnected / or / terminated. A re-connection fee may be applied.

No Water meters allowed to be installed within a driveway, sidewalk, parking lot or building structure.

Water services are required to be buried at four-foot depth and water mains at a five-foot depth. Midway requires a five-foot separation between the [culinary water](#) and the [secondary/irrigation water](#), no cross connection is allowed between the two sources. Midway requires a ten-foot separation between the [culinary water](#) and the [sanitation district/sanitary service line](#).

Midway residents are required to have a [pressure reducing device](#) installed on the home owners side of the water meter to protect against pressure spikes.

Midway City is required by State Law to supply water customers with the minimum of [20 psi of water](#) at the water meter.

Midway City has very hard water, it is recommended that you install a water softener. The settings should be between [18-24 for hardness](#).

Midway City, culinary water company is required to use chlorine in their drinking water. The state requires we are between .3 and 1.00 ppm

Rural Cross Section Requirements: All landscaping within the Midway City Street & Utility Right-of-Way, must be compliance, with the Midway City Construction Standards and Municipal Code.

Midway City Water Department requires a bulk / construction water meter to be used when using a fire hydrant. Meters & Hydrant Applications are available for daily rentals at Midway City Offices, 75 North 100 West, Midway City Utah 84049

Midway City Requires, a Street & Utility Right-of-Way Excavation Permit. Applications are available at Midway City Offices, 75 North 100 West, Midway City Utah 84049.

Note: A Class B Misdemeanor Violation: may be issued for the following items.

Water meter boxes and their contents are the property of Midway City is you need your water turned on or off please contact Midway City offices at (435) 654-3223 ext. 7 or after hours at (435) 671-7387 after hours on call employee.

Residential trash receptacles / containers can be placed on the shoulder of the pavement on the designated trash pickup days. Call (435) 654-1661 for more information on your designated trash pickup day. Trash containers and other improvements are not allowed to be placed on the pavement to mark property lines or driveways.

Construction / Building materials, Landscaping materials, Construction materials, Waste containers, Construction equipment, etc. must be stored on the building site. NO Storage or Dumping of Materials will be allowed in the City Street or Public Utility Right-of-Way. All Vehicles and Containers will be towed, materials will be confiscated. Building Permit Holders / Owner / General Contractor, will be subject to all applicable fines or fees. Permit Holder / Owner / General Contractor, assumes all responsibility for subcontractors and material suppliers regarding placement of materials or equipment in the City Street or Public Utility Right-of-Way.
