Dear Ms. Drapkin:

Reference is made to your request for Department of the Army authorization to construct a driveway and house in a wetland on your property. The site is Lot 16 in the Swiss Paradise Subdivision, located within Section 35, Township 3 South, Range 4 East, Midway, Wasatch County, Utah.

Your project has been reviewed in accordance with Section 404 of the Clean Water Act under which the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers regulates the discharge of dredged and fill material and excavation in waters of the United States including wetlands. Based on the information provided, it appears that your project would involve such discharges.

Nationwide Permit Number 26, described on the enclosed information sheet, has been issued which authorizes the discharge of dredged or fill material into headwaters and isolated waters. Your project would involve work in these wetlands and is authorized under this nationwide permit. This nationwide general permit eliminates the need for further processing for discharges which affect less than one acre of the above-mentioned waters. The construction of a driveway and house, as proposed in your permit application, will fill approximately 5000 sq. ft. of wetlands.

Your mitigation plan proposes enhancement of approximately 10,000 sq. ft. of existing wetlands on your property. Mitigation will be in the form of planting and maintenance of the existing wetlands in accordance with the Wetland Restoration Plan dated January 1994 prepared by the Utah Division of State Lands & Forestry.

The only other requirement of this nationwide general permit is that the person responsible for the project must ensure that the work complies with the conditions listed on the enclosure. Failure to satisfy these conditions invalidates the authorization and may result in a violation of the Clean Water Act.

This verification that your project is authorized by this nationwide permit is valid for two years from the date of this letter.


