





Dear Mr. Taylor:

Reference is made to your letters received March 12, 1992 and March 25, 1992, regarding your proposed construction of a single-family residence on Lot 9 of Swiss Paradise Subdivision. The site is located in Section 35, Township 3 South, Range 4 East, northeast of Midway, Wasatch County, Utah.

Your project has been reviewed in accordance with Section 404 of the Clean Water Act under which the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers regulates the discharge of dredged and fill material into waters of the United States including wetlands. Based on the information provided, it appears that your project would involve such discharges.

Nationwide Permit Number 26, described on the enclosed information sheet, has been issued which authorizes the discharge of dredged or fill material into headwaters and isolated waters. Your project would involve work in these wetlands and is authorized under this nationwide permit. This nationwide general permit eliminates the need for further processing for discharges which affect less than one acre of the above-mentioned waters. The only requirement is that the person responsible for the project must insure that the work complies with the conditions listed on the enclosure. Failure to satisfy these conditions invalidates the authorization and may result in a violation of the Clean Water Act.

This verification that your project is authorized by this nationwide permit is valid for two years. It is based on your proposed mitigation to revegetation a 9,800 square foot area with wetland trees and shrubs. This area will be placed as a deed restriction on your property deed.





 10-minute zones




