## Wasatch County cases:

Total cases to date: 1259

- Active: 327
- Recovered: 923
- Deaths: 9



12,209 people in Wasatch County have been tested for COVID-19 for a total of 15,679 tests

### Wasatch County Transmission Index Metrics:

Transmission Level:	High
7-day average percent positivity:	20.6%
14-day case rate per 100,000:	619.7
Statewide total ICU utilization:	72.6%
Statewide covid-19 ICU utilization:	20.1%

#### High Level Indicators:

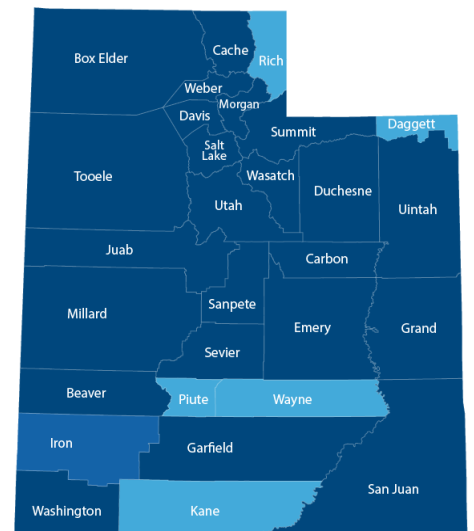
- ≥ 13% 7-day average % positivity
- ≥ 325/100k 14-day case rate
- ≥ 72% total utilization and ≥ 15% COVID-19 Statewide ICU utilization (7-day average)

**October 30, 2020** – The Utah Department of Health announced 2,292 new COVID-19 cases. That is 300 more than the previous highest number of new cases in a day. An emergency alert was sent to cell phones in the state to ensure that Utahns are aware of the dire situation we are currently in, and to make sure everyone has a chance to understand the Transmission Index and the precautions Utahns should take in each transmission level.
