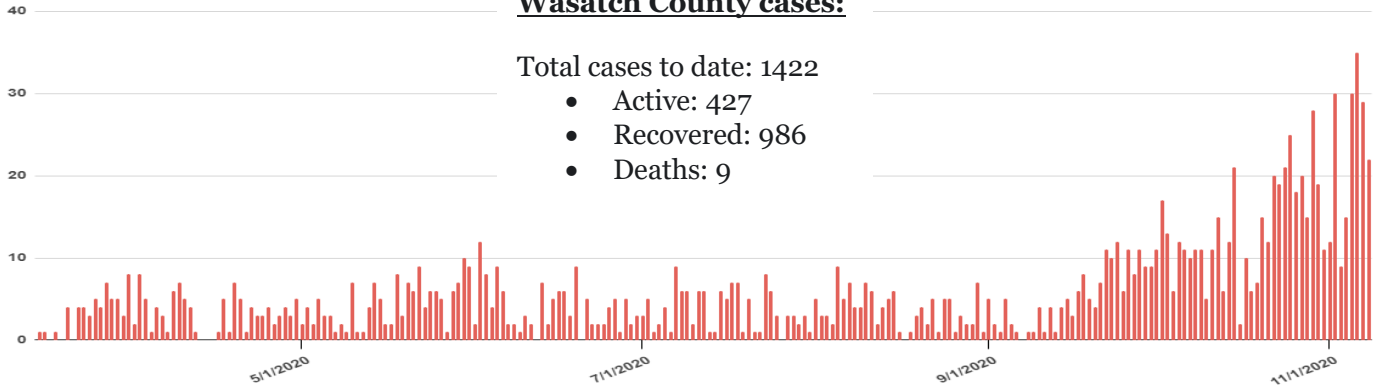

Wasatch County cases:

Total cases to date: 1422

- Active: 427
- Recovered: 986
- Deaths: 9



13,007 people in Wasatch County have been tested for COVID-19 for a total of 16,814 tests

Wasatch County Transmission Index Metrics:

	10/29/3030 (UDOH)	11/5/2020 (UDOH)
Transmission Level:	High	High
7-day average percent positivity:	20.6%	24.5%
14-day case rate per 100,000:	619.7	773.2.7
Statewide total ICU utilization:	72.6%	74.1%
Statewide covid-19 ICU utilization:	20.1%	25.1%

Statewide High Level Indicators:

- ≥ 13% 7-day average % positivity
- ≥ 325/100k 14-day case rate
- ≥ 72% total utilization and ≥ 15% COVID-19 Statewide ICU utilization (7-day average)

Transmission level is determined if a county has two of the three metrics in the designated level of transmission. Data is analyzed weekly, and counties placed into a transmission level depending solely on what their data show. Changes from a lower level to a higher level may occur weekly. Changes from a higher level to a lower level may occur every 14 days at minimum.

Governor Herbert declares State of Emergency in Utah:

November 8, 2020 – The executive order enacts the following statewide COVID-19 restrictions:

- Statewide mask mandate.
- Individuals are directed not to gather socially with anyone they do not live with.
- Individuals may not attend social gatherings that do not have an event host, as defined in the [executive order](#), through November 23, 2020.
- No organized extracurricular activities, including sports and intramural events for the duration of the order.
- Requires students enrolled at public and private colleges and universities, who either live on campus or attend at least one in-person class per week, to be tested for COVID-19 weekly. Testing is encouraged to begin as soon as possible, but must be implemented by January 1, 2021.
