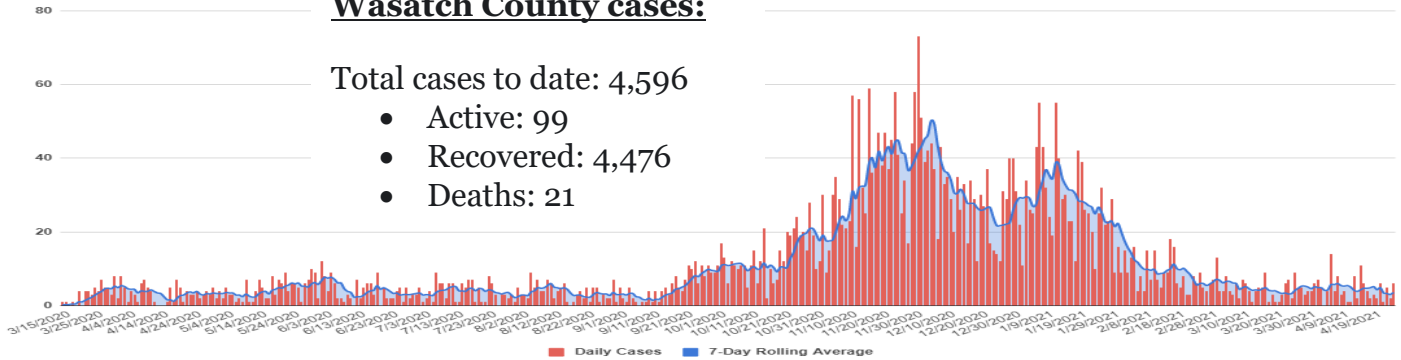

Wasatch County cases:

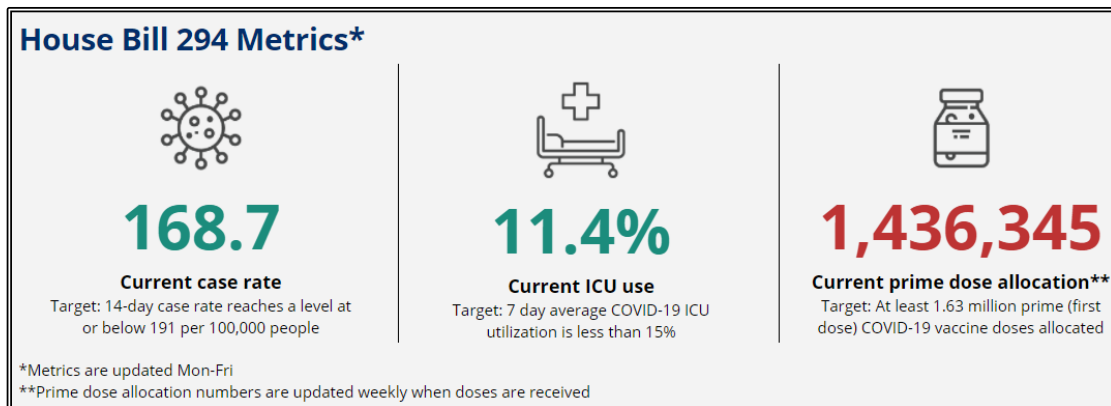
Total cases to date: 4,596

- Active: 99
- Recovered: 4,476
- Deaths: 21



House Bill 294 (April 10) - Legislative Timeline:

- Removes statewide mask mandate
- Masks still required for gatherings of 50 or more people
- Masks still required for K-12 schools (see the public health order: [Coronavirus.utah.gov](https://www.coronavirus.utah.gov))
- Masks still required in state buildings
- Businesses can still require masks for employees and customers
- County governments can enact local mask requirements
- Utah Department of Health still recommends wearing face masks to prevent the spread of COVID-19
- State and local health orders end on July 1 or when the following metrics are met:
 - 14-day case rate is at or below 191 per 100,000
 - ICU seven-day hospitalization rate is less than 15%
 - At least 1.63 million prime doses have been allocated to the state (prime doses are first doses)



Vaccine update:

Total doses administered to Wasatch County residents: 21,499

Received at least one dose: 13,079

Fully vaccinated: 9,339

Following direction from the FDA and CDC, the Utah Dept. of Health lifted the pause on administration of Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
