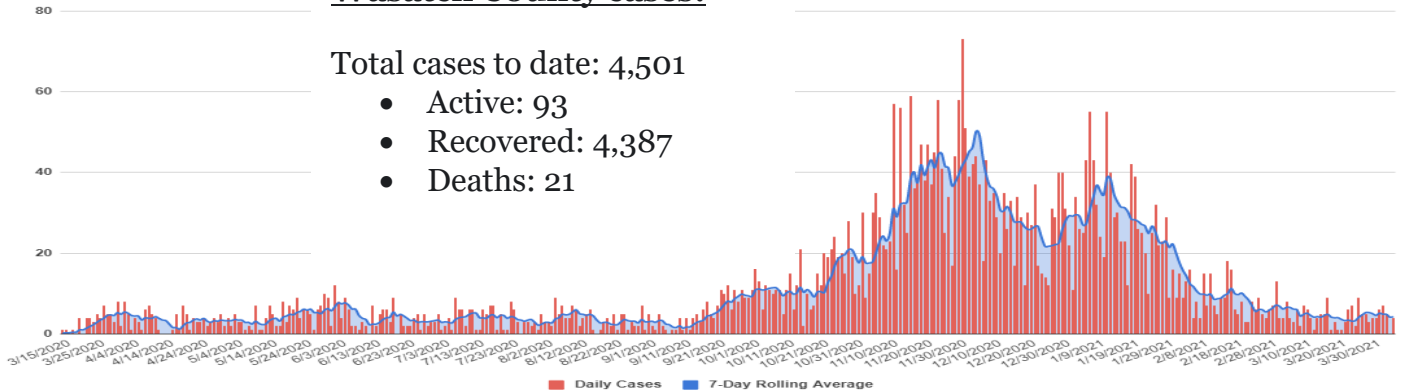

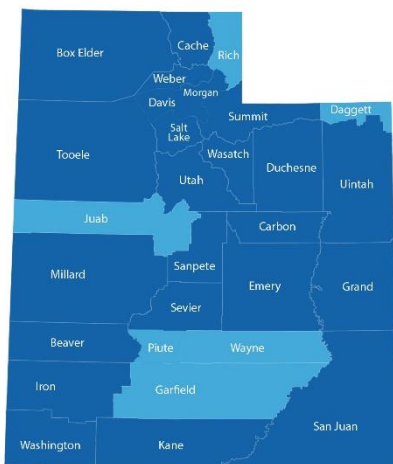
Wasatch County cases:

HB 294 signed by Governor Cox on March 23 ends certain COVID-19 restrictions including removal of the statewide mask mandate on April 10. The bill keeps in place the mask mandate and safety measures for public K-12 schools and allows private businesses the ability to keep mask requirements in place if they choose. Vaccine update:

Total doses administered to Wasatch County residents: 16,304

Received at least one dose: 10,416

Fully vaccinated: 6,398

All individuals 16 years and older are now eligible to receive COVID-19 vaccine, which is available in Wasatch County at various pharmacies and at the drive-thru clinic held at the Wasatch County Events Center parking lot.

- **Moderna and Johnson & Johnson** vaccine is available at the drive-thru clinic this week. These vaccines are approved for individuals **18 and older**. Schedule an appointment at 435-657-3276.



- Additional clinics including those providing Pfizer vaccine, which is the only vaccine approved for individuals 16-17 years old, can be found by visiting vaccinefinder.org
