Brad,

I have attached a new spreadsheet with a tab called "Lease Edits" that models out the changes to Vehicle Replacement CIP budget. Here is a high level of what I think needs to be addressed:

- Building Inspection and Admin departments will each need to stop their contributions to VR CIP, and have a General Fund line item for \$5,500 per year for vehicle leasing.
- VR CIP fund for non-PW should be transferred to another CIP fund
- Public Works will need a General Fund line item for \$40,500 per year for vehicle leasing. This could come from their current \$90,000 per year contribution to VR CIP, this should be a budget discussion point.
- If there are any contributions to VR CIP by other departments they will need to be changed to roll into the PW dept contribution.

During our discussion I can go through the spreadsheet and how changes will effect the VR CIP fund.

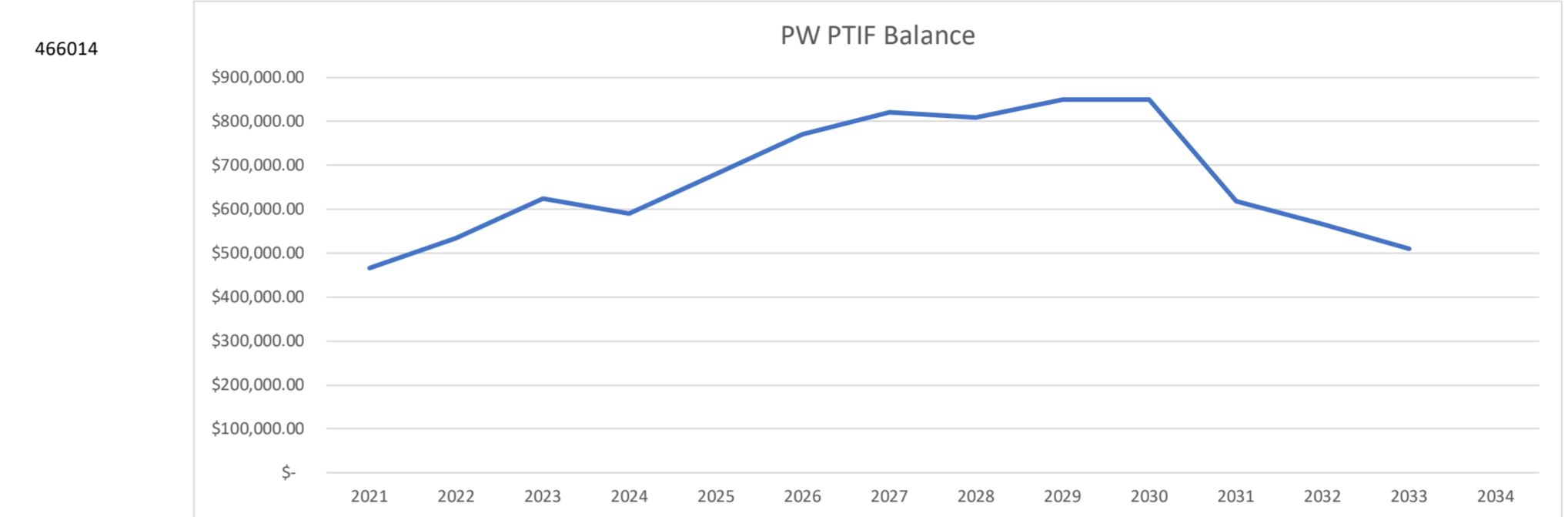

Nancy Simons, Cory Lott, Shane Owens, and I met to determine the impact of leasing vehicles on the current and future budgets. We made the following determinations:

- The annual lease cost for a vehicle for the Administration Department and the Planning Departments is \$5,500. These departments currently budget a total of \$3,000 annually for vehicle replacement. This budget will need to be increase by \$1,500 for the lease.
- The annual lease cost for a vehicle for the Building Department is \$5,500. The Department currently budgets \$5,679 annually for vehicle replacement. This budget can be reduced by \$179.
- The annual lease cost for vehicles for the Public Works Department is \$46,000. The Department currently budgets \$90,000 annually for vehicle replacement. The difference of \$44,000 can continue to be transferred to the Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) Fund for the future replacement of vehicles not leased.
- The leasing company will purchase the existing vehicles, that will be replaced by the lease, for approximately \$190,000.
- The first year, equipment like utility beds will need to be purchased for the vehicles. The initial cost will be \$74,800. This equipment will be purchased with the money received from the leasing company for the existing vehicles. The remaining \$115,200 could be transferred to the CIP Fund for the future replacement of vehicles or this equipment when it wears out. Some of the equipment, which costs less than \$5,000, will need to be purchased from the General Fund.
- It is estimated that vehicle maintenance could be reduced by \$4,500 because most maintenance would be done by the leasing company.
- \$90,000 was budgeted in the CIP Fund to purchase two new public works vehicles. This is no longer needed and may be eliminated from the budget. This will require \$90,000 less to be transferred out of the vehicle replacement reserve account.

Please note that the City would have to purchase ten vehicles if the lease was discontinued. Future increases in the lease costs are unknown and may change from year to year.

RE: CIP Fund and Leasing Vehicles

The Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) requires that governments use specific groupings or funds for accounting and budgeting. One of the allowed funds is for capital projects. This fund can be used "...to track the financial resources that are used to acquire or construct a major capital asset." Midway City, its accountants, and its auditors define major capital assets as land, buildings, building improvements, vehicles, equipment, etc. that the City will own and cost \$5,000 or more.

For several years the City has transferred money from its General Fund to its Capital Improvement Projects Fund to purchase vehicles. This money has been used for such purchases or held in reserve for vehicle replacement. Currently, the City has almost \$500,000 in this reserve account. Unfortunately, money may not be transferred out of a capital projects fund and into another fund.

Currently, the City leases equipment such as backhoes, mini-excavators, etc. These are not lease-to-own agreements. The City has the right to use the equipment but does not own it and for accounting purposes they are not shown as capital assets. The leases are paid from the General Fund and not the Capital Improvement Projects Fund.

It has been proposed that the City also lease rather than purchase many of its vehicles. This is appropriate, but the lease would be paid from the General Fund, and not the Capital Improvement Project Fund, because the vehicles would not be considered capital assets. Unfortunately, the \$500,000 in reserve in the Capital Improvement Project Fund can only be used to purchase and not lease vehicles.
