Drive technology improvements and process efficiencies/effectiveness:

- Implemented a new website and back-end membership and events management software platforms. Both have proven to provide much needed, improved systems capabilities.
- New, refreshed content is continuing to be added to the website.
- Members can join (and renew as of January 1 annually) and pay on-line seamlessly (then pick up their
 Wasatch Mountain State Park annual day-use pass at the Park). Public donations can also be made on-line.
- Registration and payment for events is now automated on-line.

Increase community outreach, communication, and fund raising:

- Member emails are starting to flow more frequently to keep members up on events and happenings.
- We are reestablishing and creating new community contacts.
- The Friends Hit & Giggle FUNdraiser is making a comeback! This event is happening! August 18th, fun 9 holes of golf followed by dinner, silent auction, 50/50 raffle and more! Registration coming soon.

2023 PROJECTS (funds are committed, but projects may be implemented and funds realized in 2024)

- Black Willow Nature Experience The Park submitted a grant to create walking trail, centerpiece, and
 nature experience around the new campground near the Chalet area. The wood from the black willow
 trees removed will be repurposed/honored to create interpretive signage, planters, etc. The Friends is part
 of this grant to contribute funding for ADA access to and/through the area.
- Archery Range 3-Dimensional Targets Deer, elk, cougars, bears, OH MY! The Friends has committed to supplement the purchase of 3-dimensional archery targets.
- New Playground Equipment for the Visitor Center The Friends will contribute to overall funding (may be through a grant) to replace the aging playground equipment.


