RESOLUTION 2023-12

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR REQUESTS FOR TAP FUNDS

WHEREAS, from time to time Midway City receives Trails, Arts and Parks ("TAP") funds from the County that may only be used for Trails, Arts or Parks; and

WHEREAS, Midway City Council has full discretion to allocate some or all of the TAP funds directly to City needs and programs but also has the discretion to award TAP money to citizen proposals that benefit the City in the designated areas; and

WHEREAS, Midway City desires to adopt formal policies and procedures regarding applying for and being awarded TAP funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby **RESOLVED** by the City Council of Midway City, Utah, as follows:

The following Policy and Procedure is hereby adopted regarding the application for and awarding of TAP funds:

- 1. The City Council will only consider applications for TAP funds twice a year and the Application must be submitted on the City approved form no later than January 30th or July 30th to be considered for an award in the six months following the submittal deadline.
- 2. All Applications submitted prior the designated deadlines established above will be considered at the same time, and the City Council may request additional information of an applicant if needed.
- 3. Consideration will be given to proposals that provide the greatest potential benefit to the most people or that meet a recognized need in the City.
- 4. While the City Council may award the entirety of available TAP funds to one applicant due to the strength of a particular proposal, it will not favor large awards, instead looking to award smaller amounts to more groups to spread the potential impact of these funds.

- 5. All Applications will be reviewed and awarded based on need, merit, and the discretion of the City Council special interest groups will not receive preference.
- 6. Filing an Application does not entitle the applicant to an award of any portion of the TAP funds the City Council may choose to dedicate the full amount of TAP funds to designated City projects or choose not to award any TAP funds to any applicant even if it has received many applications.
- 7. All parties who are awarded TAP funds will enter into a contract with the City establishing the parameters of the award and the approved uses of the TAP funds, which will include requirements to provide an accounting of how the funds were spent and a report on their impact.
- 8. Applicants are informed that awarding of TAP funds is a public process and all applications for TAP funds are available to the public upon request.

Dear Mayor and Midway City Council Members:

Can you image Swiss Days, Christmas Creche, or the Tree Lighting Festival without the melodic harmony of the Midway Swiss Bell Ringers? For nearly forty years, this handbell ensemble has been part of the fabric of these yearly events. It's what folks find uniquely charming about Midway and continues to draw them to these events year after year. No doubt, you might have been a handbell ringer yourself or remember fondly a family member who joined in the ringing of the hand bells in years past. But what would it be like if the handbells were silent?

I am writing to you today to ask for your consideration of a \$27,000 grant to retire the old worn bells, the dulled chimes, and the thread-bare costumes. The Booster Club, our sponsor, has diligently and lovingly patched and repaired the bells and costumes endless times, but in the end, our bells, chimes, equipment, and costuming are *kaput*. Annually, the Midway Boosters allot our bell choir \$500 for sheet music and the Bells Guild membership. Currently, the Boosters are incurring thousands of dollars renovating a room at the Cannery for the bell ringers practice site. Swiss Bell members finance their own transportation and travel expenses and do so because of their loyalty to Midway. There are no extra funds in the Booster coffers as the expenditures for the annual Swiss Days and Swiss Miss, 4th of July celebration, Swiss Christmas, and other Midway community activities are increasing.

As a sponsor of this \$27,000 grant an individual hand bell will be engraved with a council member's name so that every time that bell note is rung, your generosity will be heard. And, perhaps in another forty years, a bell ringer will look upon the etched name on their bell and say, "Hey, this bell was donated by my ancestor!"
